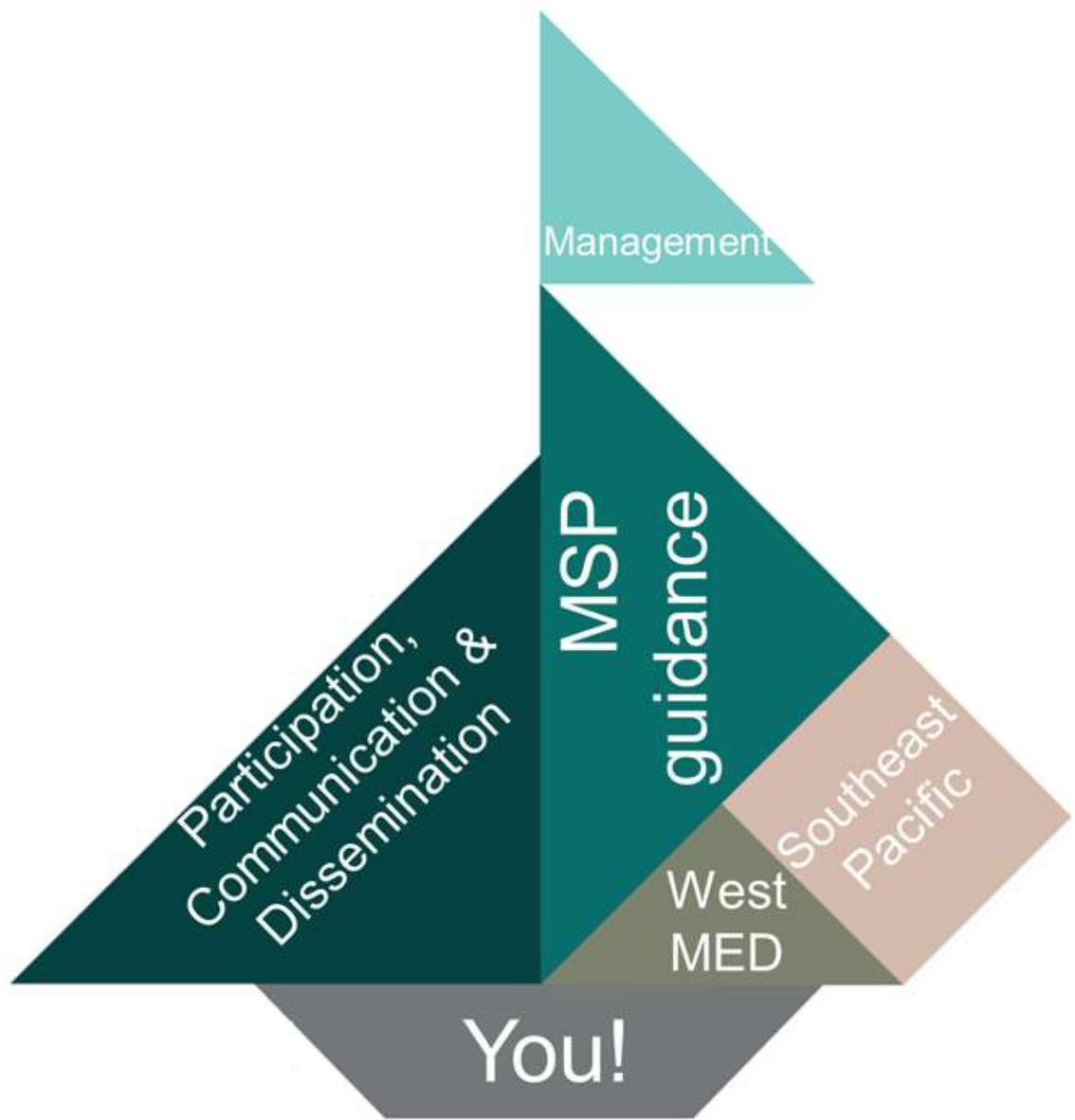
Context
