




## Land cover change indicator - crucial for the Mediterranean coastal zone:

Risk reduction - extreme weather events (flooding, erosion, damages to built assets, salt intrusion, water supply contamination and coastal water pollution...)





















The seminar, which is part of the MedProgramme, aimed to establish a common basis for the implementation of MSP within the Barcelona Convention system and provide insight into some of the most relevant and intriguing topics relevant to MSP.
